

## PCC members and Trustees registration with the Charity Commissioners.

As members of the PCC we are also trustees of the charity. A few details of each trustee need to be recorded with the Charity Commissioners. This is done online with details checked / updated shortly after the APCM each year.

The details required are:

- Title
- Full names
- Postal address
- Date of birth
- email address
- Phone number

While the register is available to be read online by anybody most of these details are not shown. An example of what can be seen in the public register is:
